In the pursuit of raising awareness on the forms of violence women and girls experience, everyone is enjoined to the national observance of the 18-Day Campaign to End Violence Against Women (VAW). In compliance to Republic Act No. 10398, series of 2012, declaring November 25 of every year as the "National Consciousness Day for the Elimination of Violence Against Women and Children," and "Presidential Proclamation No. 1172, series of 2006, declaring November 25 to December 12 of Every Year as the "18-Day Campaign to End Violence Against Women (VAWE)," the Philippine Commission on Women (PCW) has released Memorandum Circular No. 2020-07 reiterating the guidelines for the 2020 Observance of the 18-Day Campaign to End Violence Against Women (VAW) as attached herewith.
